

Local History Collection | 1852-2011 (bulk 1940-2011)

Prior to becoming incorporated as a city on November 8, 1921, Royal Oak was first established as a township on January 23, 1819, and then a village on March 18, 1891. The city's first mayor was George A. Dondero, who later went on to become a Michigan representative to the U.S. House. Though Royal Oak's first "library" appeared in 1852 as a reading room in the Township doctor's home, it was not until almost the mid-twentieth century before the city's librarians started collecting information about the city and documenting its history.

The local history collection contains atlases, tax assessment rolls, city budgets, city planning studies and other city records and documents, as well as an extensive array of newspaper clippings that primarily cover the past seventy years. Other print materials include books about the city and its residents and reference materials such as *Polk* city directories for Royal Oak and *Bresser's* cross-index directories for South Oakland County. The collection also contains yearbooks for Royal Oak High School, George A. Dondero High School, Clarence M. Kimball High School, Shrine Catholic High School & Academy, and St. Mary Catholic School starting in 1920. Digitized copies of *The Daily Tribune* from November 1877 to September 2015, digitized yearbooks for Clarence M. Kimball High School from 1958 to 2006, and a timeline of the Royal Oak Public Library's history are available on the library's website.

The bulk of the materials in the local history collection focus on Royal Oak. There is a separate filing cabinet that contains news clippings related only to Oakland County history.
