Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol-Child Endangerment, Driving While License Suspended Second Offense, Misdemeanor Warrant Arrest

On June 5, 2020, at approximately 11:45 p.m., officers were in the area of N. Campbell near Twelve Mile Rd and initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle. The driver had bloodshot eyes, slurred speech, and was acting in a confused manner. He admitted to drinking alcohol and was driving home with his 15-year-old son. His driver's license was suspended 15 times and he had a warrant for Retail Fraud from another jurisdiction.

The subject was identified as a 38-year-old Royal Oak resident. Officers arrested the subject for Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol-Child Endangerment, Driving While License Suspended and the Misdemeanor Warrants from other jurisdictions.
