Additional Incidents and Information

**Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol, Driving While License Suspended,
Misdemeanor Warrant and Failing to Stop and Identify at an Accident
Subject Arrested**

On March 5, 2021, at approximately 11:30 p.m., officers responded to a call of a reckless driver in the area of Eleven Mile and Stephenson. The officers then received information the vehicle rear ended another vehicle at Eleven Mile and Campbell.

The suspect pulled into a parking lot, exited her vehicle and began walking away from the area. The officers located her in a nearby backyard and determined she was under the influence of alcohol and had warrants for her arrest.

The driver, a 25-year-old Grosse Pointe resident, was arrested for Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol, Driving While License Suspended, Misdemeanor Warrant and Failing to Stop and Identify at an Accident.

Possession of Cocaine, Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol and Narcotic Paraphernalia Subject Arrested

On March 6, 2021, at approximately 8:30 a.m., officers conducted a traffic stop near N. Campbell and E. Hudson. The officer spoke to the driver of the vehicle and she appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. The driver had an open can of beer in the cupholder of her vehicle. After she was placed under arrest the officers located a small baggie of cocaine with narcotic paraphernalia in her pockets.

The driver, a 40-year-old Ferndale resident, was arrested for Possession of Cocaine, Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Narcotic Paraphernalia.

Possession of Heroin, Possession of Crack, and Narcotic Paraphernalia Subject Arrested

On March 7, 2021, at approximately 5:15 a.m., officers conducted a traffic stop near N. Campbell and 12 Mile. The officer spoke to the driver of the vehicle and observed narcotic paraphernalia on the floorboard of the vehicle. The officer had the driver exit his vehicle and discovered he had crack cocaine in his pockets and heroin inside the vehicle.

The driver, a 54-year-old Madison Heights resident, was arrested for Possession of Heroin, Possession of Crack, and Narcotic Paraphernalia.
