Operating While Intoxicated and Carrying Concealed Weapon Under the Influence of Alcohol Subject Arrested

On April 12, 2021, at approximately 9:15 a.m., officers conducted a traffic stop near W. Thirteen Mile and Benjamin Ave. for a vehicle speeding. The officers could smell alcohol coming from the driver and he disclosed he had a firearm in the center console of the vehicle.

The driver, a 41-year-old Clawson resident, was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated and Carrying a Concealed Weapon While Under the Influence of Alcohol.

Trespassing Subject with Misdemeanor Warrants Arrested

On April 15, 2021, at approximately 6:30 a.m., officers responded to Starbucks at 31901 Woodward for a disorderly subject harassing customers. Officers arrived and observed the subject yelling at customers in their vehicles in the drive thru. Management advised the subject had been advised on trespassing in the past.

The subject, a 51-year-old Hazel Park resident, was arrested for Trespassing and the multiple misdemeanor warrants.

Stabbing Investigation

The Royal Oak Police Department is investigating a stabbing that occurred at Hookah Joes at 734 S. Washington, on March 13, 2021, at approximately 1:00 a.m.

This incident began inside the establishment, when a female bumped into a table and had a verbal altercation with the people at the table. After the altercation, the female returned with two additional females and a male. The female suspect punched the male victim sitting at the table and the male suspect brandished a knife and stabbed him in the abdomen.

The suspects fled from the business to their vehicle which was parked in the parking lot on S. Washington, north of Hookah Joes. There were numerous customers still inside the location when the stabbing occurred. No other injuries were reported.

The suspects fled the area in a black 4 door SUV.

Suspect #1 is described as a 5'10", dark skinned black male, with a medium build wearing black clothing with a black jacket with red and black writing on it.

Suspect #2 is described as a light skinned black female, with a medium build wearing black pants, white Detroit "Bad Boys" crew neck shirt and with her hair up.


The victim went to WBH and was treated for non-life-threatening injuries.
