The Royal Oak Police Department would like to introduce Officer Drew Nadrowski, the department's newest K-9 handler, and his partner named Thorvi. She is a 1.5-year-old female Belgian Malinois from Shallow Creek Kennels in Pennsylvania.

Officer Nadrowski spent six weeks of extensive training with her. Thorvi will be a dual-purpose animal trained in tracking/apprehension and explosive detection. She is also the first female K-9 assigned for duty in the unit.

She will reside with Officer Nadrowski and his family and it is great to hear she is awesome with children!

Her name came with her from the Netherlands and means "Goddess of Thunder" in Dutch.
